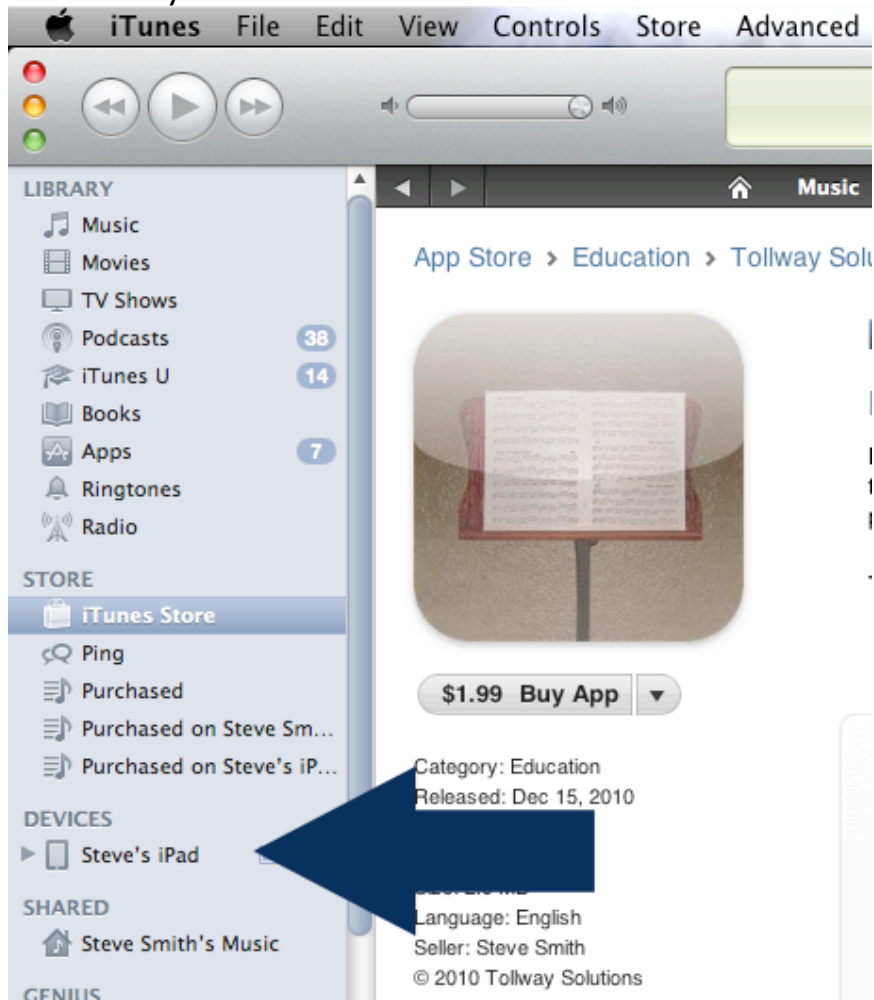
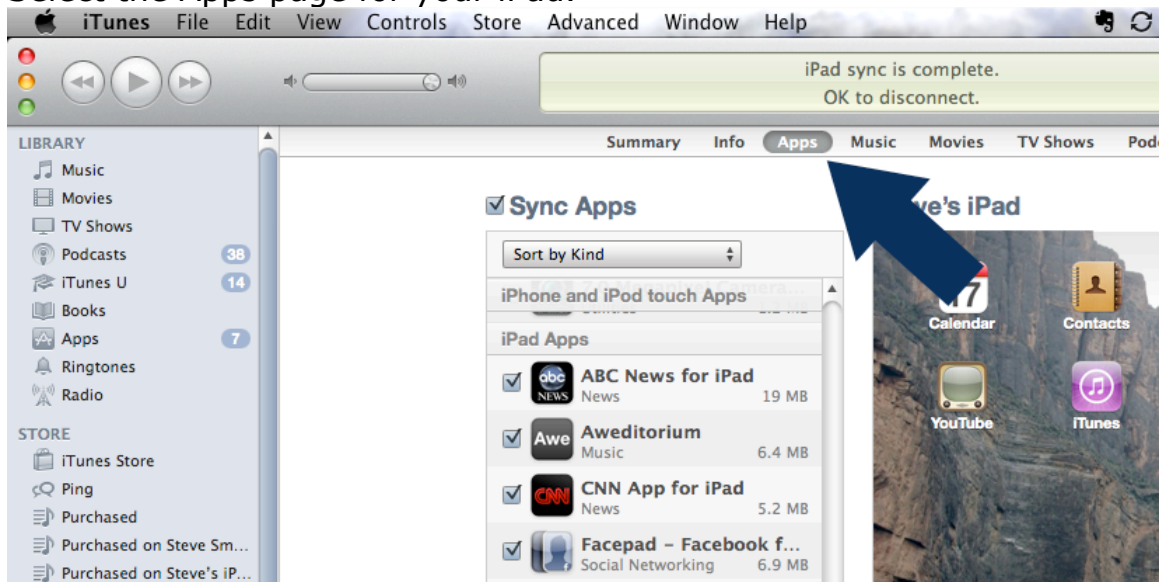


How to use iTunes File Sharing to load your sheet music onto Music Rack.

1. Download Music Rack from the iTunes store on your iPad, or from iTunes and then Sync your iPad with iTunes.
2. Copy all of the music files (Must be PDF for Sheet Music and MP3 for recordings) into one folder on your PC.
3. Connect your iPad to your PC and open iTunes.
4. Select your iPad from this list of items in iTunes.



5. Select the Apps page for your iPad.

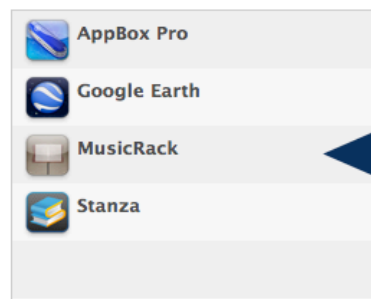


6. Scroll to the bottom of the apps page to find the apps on your iPad that support File Sharing and select Music Rack.

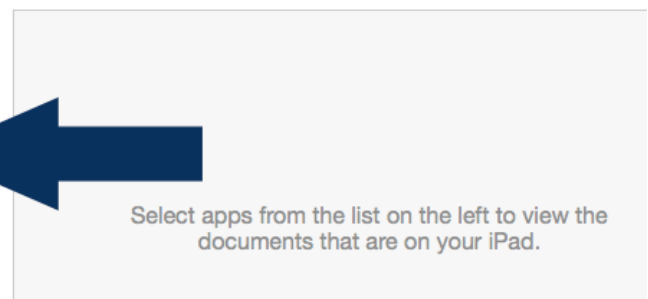

The apps listed below can transfer documents between your iPad and this computer.

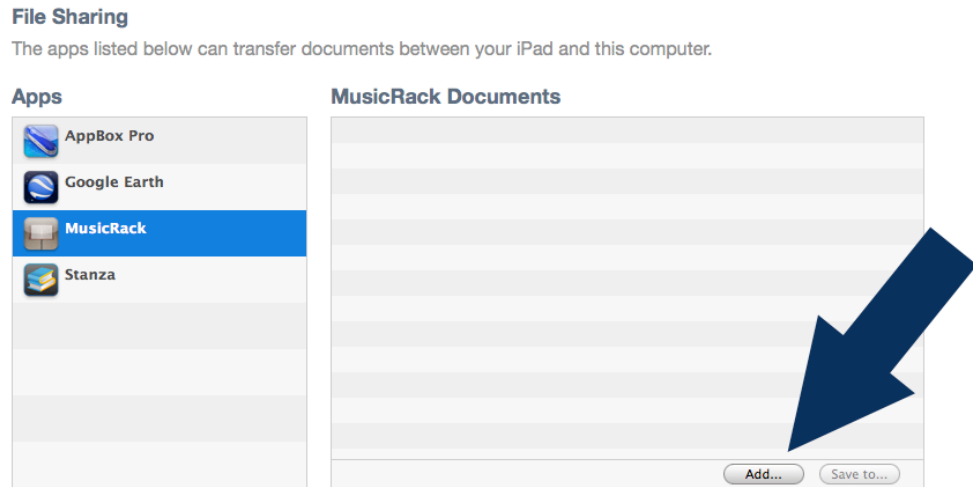

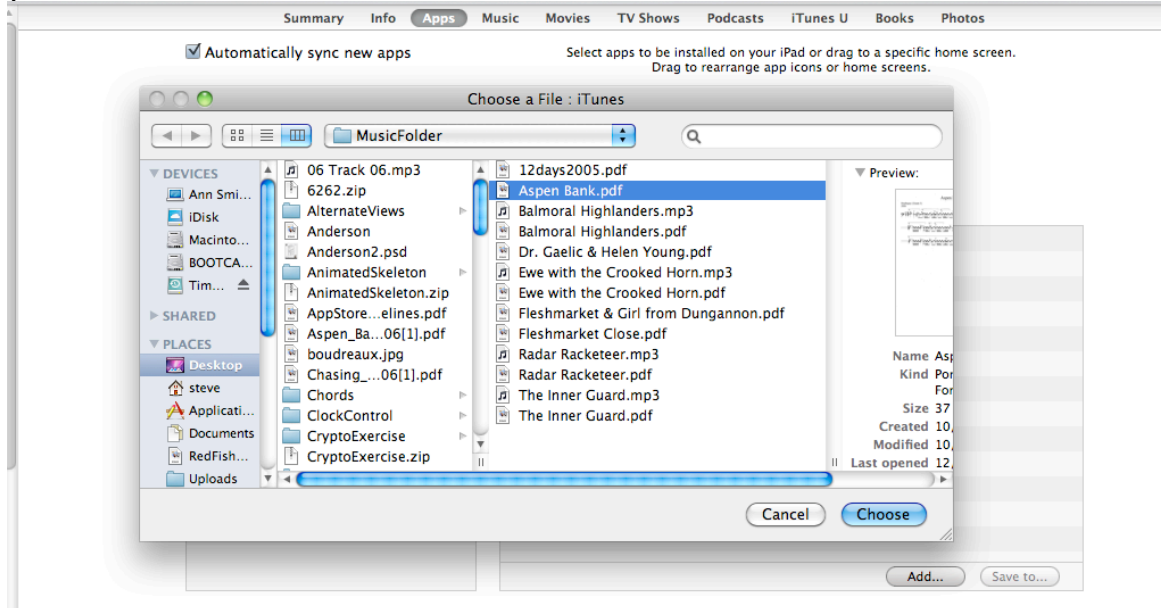

7. Click on the add button to add files to Music Rack.



8. Navigate to your music folder on your PC and select all of the files that you want to sync to your iPad. (Use Shift Click to select groups of files, and command-click to select multiple individual files – Command A to select all files in a folder). After clicking the Choose button, you'll see the list of files added to your Music Rack Documents list in iTunes.



9. Press the Sync button on the bottom right corner of iTunes, and iTunes will load the selected files onto your iPad. They are added to the iPad, not moved, so they remain in place on your PC as well.
